Multiple Vulnerabilities in in Oracle Products

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed Multiple Vulnerabilities in Oracle Products, which could be potentially exploited by a malicious user to compromise an affected system.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

1.CVE-2024-20917

- CVSS Base Score: 7.5 HIGH
- A vulnerability exists in the Oracle Enterprise Manager Base Platform that could allow an unauthenticated attacker with network access to compromise the system. Successful attacks require human interaction from a person other than the attacker and may significantly impact additional products. An attacker could exploit this vulnerability to gain unauthorized access to critical data, modify or delete data, or cause a denial-of-service condition.

2.CVE-2024-20939

- CVSS Base Score: 4.3 MEDIUM
- A vulnerability exists in the Oracle CRM Technical Foundation product of Oracle E-Business Suite (component: Admin Console)., A low privileged attacker with network access can exploit this vulnerability to cause a partial denial-of-service (DoS) condition.

Affected Products:

Oracle CRM Technical Foundation v12.2.3-v12.2.13

Oracle Enterprise Manager Base Platform v13.5.0.0

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends applying the mitigation or workaround provided by Oracle.
