Apple's Zero-Click Shortcuts Vulnerability

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed a zero-click shortcut vulnerability in Apple products that could be exploited to obtain sensitive data from affected devices.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Vulnerabilities Details:

- **CVE-2024-23204**
- CVSS Base Score: 7.5 HIGH
- A vulnerability exists in Apple's Shortcuts application. This vulnerability could allow an attacker to access sensitive data on a user's device without prompting the user for permission.
- An attacker could potentially exploit this vulnerability to gain access to sensitive information on a vulnerable device, such as contacts, location data, photos, or even passwords.

Latest Versions:

- iOS 17.3.1, iPadOS 17.3.1, macOS Sonoma 14.3.1, and watchOS 10.3.1

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends applying the security updates recently released by Apple.
