**Threat Actor Claims to be Selling UAE related Vulnerabilities on BreachForums**

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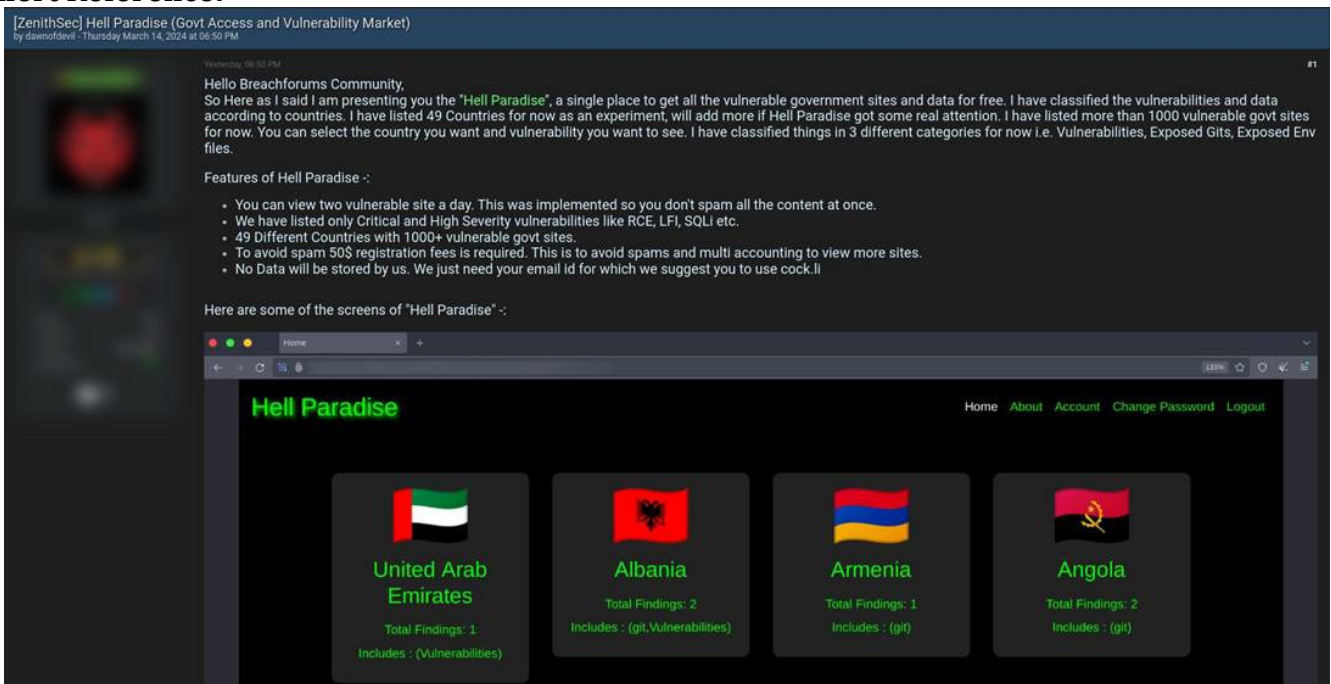
## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed a threat Actor claims to be selling UAE related vulnerabilities on breachforums. The extent of the breach is unclear, and this situation poses a significant risk. It is crucial for entities to take proactive measures.

## TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Threat Intelligence was notified of a Breachforums post where the Threat Actor aliased 'dawnofdevil' claims to be promoting 'Hell Paradise,' an onion website aimed at obtaining vulnerable government sites and data for free. The threat actor states that 49 countries have been listed for now as an experiment, including UAE (1 finding for now), along with more than 1000 vulnerable government sites. The critical and high-severity vulnerabilities are listed, such as RCE, LFI, SQLi, etc.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Remain vigilant and attentive to any unusual events or actions that may indicate malicious intent.
- Consider anti-DDoS solutions from ISPs or security vendors, if already subscribed then verify the anti-DDoS configuration.
- Notify immediately if any unusual or concerning findings are discovered.
- Implement strong authentication methods, such as multi-factor authentication (MFA), for all critical systems and applications.
- Ensure that all software, operating systems, and security applications are up to date with



the latest patches and updates.

- Regularly back up the data and store it in a secure location
- Monitor network traffic for unusual or suspicious activities using intrusion detection systems (IDS) and intrusion prevention systems (IPS).
