REGISTRATION AUTHORITY CIRCULAR NO. (11) OF 2020: Obligations of ADGM Licenced Persons in relation to temporary suspension of activities as part of ongoing health and safety measures in Al Maryah Island

This circular replaces Registration Authority Circular No. (10) of 2020.

The purpose of this circular is to inform all Abu Dhabi Global Market (ADGM) Licenced Persons of the temporary suspension and restriction of certain activities and services in the ADGM Financial Free Zone (Al Maryah Island), as set out below.

In the context of ongoing preventative and precautionary measures to ensure individual health and safety as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19), the Registration Authority imposes the following temporary suspensions and restrictions in Al Maryah Island.

Hotels

ADGM Licenced Hotels must cease the following activities / services until further notice:

1. Spas;
2. Lounges and bars (including cigar lounges but excluding hotel lobby lounges, subject to capacity restrictions and guest distancing requirements);
3. Kids clubs, play areas and entertainment facilities;
4. Swimming pools; and
5. Gyms.

Hotel Restaurants, Tourism and Food Establishments (excluding outdoor kiosks)

Hotel restaurants, tourism establishments and food establishments (e.g. cafes) must abide by the following:

1. Restaurants with bars must cease service at the bar areas;
2. Seating must be limited to twenty percent (20%) of an establishment's capacity;
3. A distance of two (2) meters between tables or groups of guests must be maintained; and
4. Delivery services may continue.

All sanitation and hygiene measures previously announced, including the use of disposable plates, cups and cutlery for guests, must continue to be observed.

Convenience / Grocery Stores and Supermarkets

Convenience / grocery stores and supermarkets must ensure a distance is kept between customers queuing for payment.

Parks

Closure of public and private parks on Al Maryah Island.

The above requirements are effective immediately until further notice. The Registration Authority will assess and update these measures consistent with UAE Government Authority announcements.

Violation of these suspensions and restrictions will be subject to regulatory action.
