To: All ADGM Licenced Persons

REGISTRATION AUTHORITY CIRCULAR NO. (17) OF 2020: Continuation of the temporary closure of all places of worship (including ablution facilities) in Al Maryah Island

This circular replaces Registration Authority Circular No. (8) of 2020.

The purpose of this circular is to inform all Abu Dhabi Global Market (ADGM) Licenced Persons that consistent with the ongoing suspension of prayers in all places of worship across the UAE, places of worship must remain temporarily closed in the ADGM Financial Freezone (Al Maryah Island).

In the context of ongoing preventative and precautionary measures to ensure individual health and safety as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19), the National Crisis Emergency and Disasters Management Authority with the General Authority of Islamic Affairs and Endowments has announced that the temporary suspension of prayers shall remain in place until further notice.

Consistent with this announcement the Registration Authority requires that all prayer rooms (including ablution facilities) and areas of worship in the ADGM continue to remain closed until further notice.

The above requirement is effective immediately and until further notice.
