REGISTRATION AUTHORITY CIRCULAR NO. (28) OF 2021: preventative measures for events and exhibitions on Al Maryah Island

This circular replaces Registration Authority Circular No. (26) of 2021 in respect of preventative measures for events and exhibitions.

The purpose of this circular is to inform all Abu Dhabi Global Market (ADGM) licensed hotels, tourism establishments, shopping malls, event organisers and owners, cultural and entertainment venues in the ADGM Financial Free Zone (Al Maryah Island), of the requirements for events and exhibitions, as set out below.

The following are health and safety preventative and precautionary requirements applicable in the ADGM.

Section 1 – Indoor Events & Exhibitions

1. Use the Green Pass protocols.
2. Negative PCR test required which is not more than 96 hours old.
3. EDE test at all entry points (thermal scanning can be replaced with EDE or remain in place).
4. Wearing face masks is mandatory.
5. Exempt international visitors and participants who are not vaccinated from the Green Pass require a negative PCR test which is not more than 48 hours old (citizens and residents are not included).
6. Operating at the site to not exceed 80% of capacity.

Section 2 – Outdoor Events

7. Use the Green Pass protocols.
8. EDE test at all entry points (thermal scanning can be replaced with EDE or remain in place).
9. Wearing face masks is mandatory.

Section 3 – Weddings

10. Operating capacity is set to 60% and the number of attendees does not exceed 100 in indoor halls.
11. Operating capacity is set to 60% and the number of attendees does not exceed 300 outdoors.

The above requirements shall supersede in case of conflict with any previous circular and are effective from 30 November 2021 until further notice.

The Registration Authority monitors adherence with these requirements.

Non-compliance with these requirements may result in regulatory action including financial penalties starting from USD 800 and up to USD 10,000 and/or commercial licence cancellation.
